#### **Gail Jones**

Nathan "Gail" Jones started shooting trap in May 1975. His first round was 12 out of 25, and the scores went up from there, In his lifetime he registered 135,000 ATA targets along with 78,850 PITA targets. Over 45 years of registered shooting, he has accumulated a room full of all kinds of trophies plus a few buckets full of pins. Gail was also a league shooter and sponsored several teams which won many scratch league championships, and he was prolific turkey/buddy backer shooter. He was a life member of the Twin Falls Gun Club, the NRA and annual member of other clubs in the state. Gail has been instrumental in helping with team shoots, fundraising turkey shoots with local law enforcement, and teaching kids, women and anyone else in need of help shooting.

Gale served as a director in the ISTA and the PITA, was a Twin Falls board member for many years, serving as President multiple times. During his involvement, many projects and general improvements were completed. Gail along with his Wife Phyllis, donated the kitchen equipment and labor when the kitchen was remodeled at the club.

Gail shot many 100 straights in singles and also recorded 100 straights in handicap and doubles. He even shot on a 499 singles squad. Guess who had the 99?!

His gun collection of rifles, pistols and numerous shotguns include Perazzis, which were his favorite i.e. TM1, MX8 and RS High Tech. Gail had a room full of reloading supplies for his three reloaders, and cases of Remington shells, his favorite. He kept Sportsman's Warehouse supplied with empty hulls!

At the age of 70 he had a 94 ATA singles average and at the age of 79 and 80 he was opening the gun club on Thursdays for practice. He also had time to play cribbage and gin rummy. Gail did not know a stranger and loved talking with everyone. He truly enjoyed shooting at the state shoots. The Pocatello Gun Shoot and the PITA Grand were among his favorites. In 2019, the year before he regrettably passed away, he still was a fine competitor taking PITA Grand Elder Singles Champion with 100, he also won the PITA State Elder Doubles Championship, With a voice and laugh that were so "Big" you could always find him in a crowded club house was the way in one of his granddaughters described him so very accurately. That seems like a fitting memory to a great gentleman of the sport.

#### **Chester Carter**

Chester Carter began shooting trap in Ohio at age16. In 1968 he joined the Air Force, & while stationed at Hill AFB, Utah he began shooting again as a member of the USAF trap team. In 1982 Chester was in Pruem, Germany where he ran the Bitberg AFB Gun Club. He enjoyed shooting International trap in Germany, Belgium & Luxenberg. In 1988 Chester retired from the Air Force & moved to Boise, Idaho where he has been a member of the Boise Gun Club ever since.

After leaving the Air Force he began working for the Federal Aviation Administration & spent 24 years working on heavy ground radar systems. That led to him having close to 45 years of experience working on radar systems.

Chester is a life member of the ATA & the NRA. His many trapshooting accomplishments include being named member of the ATA All American Team in 2017 and making the PITA All Star Team five times to date. His lengthy and very impressive list of wins began in 1991 with a Co-Champion Handicap win at Walla Walla, Washington. Carter continued taking trophies at state, zone and PITA Grand events with well over 70 titles. These include many championship titles in PITA and ATA state shoots including Montana, Oregon, Idaho, and Nevada State Shoots. He likes to travel to the Autumn Grand at Tucson, where he is quite successful, collecting eight titles over the years.

Chester has vastly contributed to the sport of trapshooting. He served on the Boise Gun Club board for about nine years, served on the PITA state board for a couple more years, and was the alternate ATA Delegate for an additional year. Never afraid of work, Chester has repaired traps, installed voice release systems and card readers, mowed weeds and removed snow. He was a volunteer at the 1998 Grand American and also volunteered at various clubs both in and out of Idaho. He helped run many different state shoots by maintaining and repairing trap machines, speakers and setting targets.

When we asked Chester to send us his shooting history, including specific dates, he replied "you ask for dates and I can't remember what I had for breakfast!" demonstrating his wonderful sense of humor.

#### Joe Eichert

Joe Eichert began his shooting career in 1970 & has been shooting registered targets ever since. He is a life member of Orofino Gun Club & ATA; & an annual member of the PITA. Currently his ATA target total is 119,175.

Here are a few of his many contributions to the sport:

#### Camas Prairie Trapshooting Association (CPTA):

Joe has been a director on the CPTA Board since 1970. He has served as an officer and has never missed a CPTA shoot. He was VP in 1974, 1981, 1987, & 2009; served as President in 1997. He has served on the CPTA Handicap, Grievance, Trapsetting, Shoot-Off and Trophies Committees.

#### Idaho State Trapshooting Association (ISTA)

Joe served on the ISTA in multiple roles. During his tenure on the board the association thrived, & his presence & participation contributed to its success. His recent efforts have helped the ISTA become financially sound, & contributed to the quality of the annual Idaho State Shoot. He was on the ISTA Board of Directors 1975-1987 and has again been serving on the BOD as secretary-treasure since 2017. He was VP for 3 years and was Secretary Treasurer for 7 years before returning to that role currently.

#### Orofino Gun Club:

Trapshooting Program.

Orofino-Pierce Gun Club was originally located on leased Nez Perce Tribal Grounds. In early 1990's the club was notified the lease would not be renewed. An all-out search was launched to locate a new site to establish a club. Joe found a site on an old homestead owned by Potlatch Corporation. He was instrument in securing the lease and acquiring the necessary easement. During the development and building phases of the new club they remained active in the Camas Prairie competition by having members shoot at Nezperce Gun Club, & hosting their annual shoot at the Lewiston Gun Club. The first registered shoot at the new club was held in March 1999. Joe's hard work & commitment were major factors that kept the club active & intact during this time, remaining in good standing with the ATA and the ISTA. In 2014 the club was able to purchase 34 acres & since Joe has helped obtain 3 grants from the Friends of the NRA, enabling the gun club to upgrade traps and start an active, competitive Junior

Joe has shot from Class D to AA & back down again. He was punched to the 27 yard line four times. His list of trophies is considerable highlighted by Camas All Star Teams in 1986 and 1989. Joe made the state team in 1975. He has taken High Overall and High All Around wins in Idaho, Montana and Washington just to mention a few.

Joe's lifetime contribution to the sport of trapshooting sets a high bar of achievement, and presents an inspiration to everyone associated with the sport.

#### Liz Harris

Liz Harris will be joining her Idaho State Hall of Fame husband Kent to form the third husband and wife team in the state Hall of Fame. Virgil & Viva Baldwin; Dan & Darlene McKenzie are the other two. Liz will also be inducted into the PITA Hall of Fame at ceremonies at the PITA Grand in July. A very well deserved honor for a person that has put so much effort & volunteered so much of her time & energy to make the shooting experience so much better for all of us.

Liz began shooting at the Boise & Caldwell Gun Clubs in 1982., shooting her first registered target in 1984. While these would become her two "home" clubs over the years, she would also had memberships in several others, including Ontario, Twin Falls, and Burley. Over Liz's shooting career of 36 years, she roamed the Northwest, shooting at clubs in Idaho, Oregon, Nevada, Washington, British Columbia, & Utah. At many of these clubs Liz was quick to lend a hand where she found a need, & helped several clubs with their first registered shoots. In her shooting career, Liz has amassed an impressive list of wins & awards within both the PITA & ISTA.

#### Pacific International Trap Association (PITA)

Liz has taken wins at over thirty PITA shoots. She reigned Champion in various Lady Classes, Doubles, Handicap, & Singles events. She has garnered trophies at Idaho PITA State, Oregon State, Nevada State, & Grand Pacific shoots.

Liz was a 29 time member of the Idaho PITA All-Star Team, six times as Ladies Team Captain or Co-Captain. She was the first woman shooter from Idaho to register 100,000 PITA targets, and earned placement on the PITA High Over All teams list in C Class in 2015 and B Class in 2019. Over the past 30 plus years has served as an official for the Idaho PITA & an un-official representative at the PITA executive level.

#### Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA)

Liz also earned numerous ATA trophies at local and State shoots, including wins in Lady Handicap, Singles, Lady Preliminary Handicap, Husband and Wife, and Lady High Combined.

Liz and Kent Harris married in 1986. Along the way, Liz raised two daughters & had a 31 year teaching career. She shot when she could, but not as often as she wanted. In 2007 she was punched to the 25 yard line, & looked to be on her way to the 27; but, she ran into health problems that affected her shooting, & eventually caused her retirement from teaching. Liz has spent time in the past few years being a caregiver to several family members. She hopes to continue shooting in the future, adding more clubs (& wins) to her list, while meeting new people & continuing to enjoy the sport of trapshooting.



#### IDAHO SHOTGUN SPORTS MUSEUM INC.

Hi everyone. Well, Covid slowed down or changed many of our shooting activities in 2020 and it also affected the progress of fundrasing and planning for contruction for the ISSM project. We were able to accomplish several things during the slowdown however.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

Orange dome pitch targets will be used. The shoot will be conducted on 8 program traps. PRACTICE TRAPS - Will open at 8:00 a.m. Purchase tickets at member prices at the counter. Breakfast and lunch available.

SHOOT-OFFS - Ties will be shot off at the end of each day. Be there or forfeit.

TARGET SETTING – Target setting will be under the direction of the Boise Gun Club with supervision by the Idaho PITA. No targets will be changed without permission from a Boise Gun Club or Idaho PITA Representitive to make the change.

REFUNDS - No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after the event has started. Also, no purse or options will be accepted after the first score sheet is posted. All refunds will be mailed with the payoffs. NO CASH REFUNDS.

CONDUCT - The Idaho PITA and the Boise Gun Club reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who in any way interferes with the safety, harmony, and enjoyment of this shoot.

GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE - Will be the Idaho PITA board members.

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION - All shooters who have shot less than 500 registered handicap targets since they have started shooting will shoot at 22 yards for the State shoot only\*. All shooters who have shot less than 500 registered 16 yard targets will shoot singles in A class for the State shoot only. All shooters who have shot less than 200 registered doubles targets will shoot in B class for the State shoot only. \* Juniors, Sub-Juniors and Ladies may shoot at 20 yards.

#### ATA targets will count toward target requirements.

#### SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

- A Sub-junior is a person who has not attained their 15th birthday. For events where no Sub-junior trophy is offered, Sub-juniors shall be eligible to compete for the Junior trophy.
- A Junior is a person who has attained their 15th birthday but has not attained their 18th birthday.
- A Veteran is a person who has attained their 65th birthday but has not attained their 70th birthday.
- A Senior Veteran is a person who has attained their 70th birthday but has not attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Senior Veteran trophy is offered, Senior Veterans shall be eligible to compete for the Veteran trophy.
- An Elder is a person who has attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Elder trophy is offered, Elders shall be eligible to compete for the oldest category trophy available.
- A Rookie is any shooter who has shot less than one calendar year from the time they shot their first registered targets.

<u>Failure to Fire rule.</u> - You are allowed two failures to fire per sub-event in the 16 yard, handicap, and doubles events. It is not counted as a failure to fire if a "no target" is thrown. Check your rule book for details.

Handicap Rule. All shooters will shoot their longest handicap yardage, ATA or PITA.

BROKEN TARGET RULE - When a broken target is thrown, regardless of whether the shooter shoots at the target or not, it is declared "NO TARGET".

The State Board of Directors and the Boise Gun Club reserve the right to change or modify any part of the program, if necessary.
