GENERAL INFORMATION

A.T.A. rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All targets are registered. Additional I.S.T.A. rules are listed below.

The State Executive Committee has complete charge of this shoot. Their decisions in all matters will be final.

Double check your entry cards. Be sure your Class, Yardage and all other information is correct and is legible.

Office Hours: Tuesday & Wednesday – 8:00 am - 4:30 pm

Thursday, Friday & Saturday – 7:30 am - 4:30 pm

Sunday – 8:00 am - End of shoot

No shooter will be considered entered until their entry is paid.

The 2011 State Shoot trapline will be arranged 1 to 34. Targets will be shot 100 per trap. Starting at 11:00 am, July 19, shooters may squad for the entire week by PICKING THEIR TRAP. You must be classified and have a current ATA and ISTA membership prior to squadding. Squadding will be handled on a first come first serve basis.

All purses and options must be played when entering; no additions or cancellations permitted after entry is made.

No entries refunded unless the event is cancelled.

All events will be held rain or shine.

During rush periods it will be necessary to take entries for that day only.

All information needed to: Award Trophies, Award Added Money and make report to the A.T.A. is taken from the scoreboard Bulletin Sheets. It is each shooter's responsibility to check all scores and information for each event, and be sure they are correct. The Bulletin Sheets will be left up for one hour after each event is finished so each shooter has time to have any score, etc. checked. Once the Bulletin Sheets have been removed from the Bulletin Board, all purses, options, added money, etc. will be figured from the scores that are posted when they are removed. *We will not refigure any money because a wrong posted score is brought to our attention the following day.*

The scorer must call upon an I.S.T.A. Official to settle any controversy regarding a score, or when an error has been made by being ahead or behind in his scoring.

The Executive Committee reserves the right to call off or to change any portion of the program due to bad weather or other just causes.

If students are concerned about their amateur status, they should forfeit all trophies and added money.

All Lewis money will be paid 60-40% (percentage).

DAILY FEES: ATA \$2.00; ISTA \$2.00.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

All Iowa Shooters must have their current I.S.T.A. Membership Card.

All Shooters must have their current A.T.A. Membership Card.

All Shooters must have all scores posted and averages figured on A.T.A. Card before presenting it to the Classification Committee or shoot penalty class and yardage.

BE READY TO COMPETE WHEN YOUR SQUAD IS CALLED TO THE FIRING LINE. THERE WILL BE NO WAITING FOR A LATE SHOOTER.

Squad hustlers have the authority to move squads to different nearby traps at any time. This will be done in an effort to expedite the progress of events.

All squads must shoot in their correct numerical sequence. All shooters must shoot in the squad and position as assigned to them by the office. To do otherwise means disqualification.

A shooter can only make up one sub-event (25 targets) on the practice trap and the balance of the targets will not be scored. If you are unable to join your squad when they start their second sub-event, you must be resquadded and pay a \$10 resquadding fee. All make-ups please report to an I.S.T.A. Official at the practice trap. If the event has been closed and there is no place to resquad, you will not be allowed to make-up.

A fee of \$10 will be charged if you change your squad AFTER you have entered the event. This fee will be enforced at the 2011 Iowa State Shoot! If the office changes you because your yardage changes, no fee will be assessed.

Check score after each completed post, and be sure they are scored correctly before firing at a target on the next post. *Any target scored both dead and lost must be identified in writing or the target will be scored as lost in the office.*

Only errors in addition can be corrected after a score sheet leaves the trap.

High scores and ties in each class will be advanced one class for the next day's competition. Yardage winners report to classification desk. Shooters responsibility or be disqualified.

All shooters must declare their SPECIAL CATEGORY AT CLASSIFICATION.

TROPHIES

The intent of the I.S.T.A. regarding the winning of trophies: No shooter may win more than one trophy per event except on concurrent awards. Current A.T.A. rules apply to all trophies.

Shooters may no longer fall back on special category trophies after an unsuccessful class shoot-off. Shooter must choose which trophy he/she will take or shoot off for.

A Sub-Junior cannot win a Junior trophy unless there is no trophy for the Sub-Junior.

A Senior Veteran cannot win a Veteran trophy unless there is no trophy for the Senior Veteran.

Champions, Runner-ups & 3rd Place winners are not eligible for class or yardage group trophies.

NO TROPHIES WILL BE MAILED. Either pick them up yourself or have a personal representative pick them up for you.

Winner of an A.T.A. trophy is not eligible for a state trophy in the same event.

IF THERE ARE EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE RULES,
IT WILL BE NOTED IN THE PROGRAM FOR THAT DAY AND EVENT.

Eye and Hearing Protection must be worn at all times during the Iowa State Trap Shoot.

Any shooter who consumes any drug or alcoholic beverage during participation in any event, sub-event or between events or sub-events, including shoot-offs and practice, will be disqualified from further participation in that day's events.

CLASSIFICATION

Minimum target requirements must be shot before Wednesday, July 20, 2011. Exceptions - Ladies, Veterans, Sr. Veterans, Juniors and Sub-Juniors.

EMT's ON DUTY

TARGET SETTING

The Target Setting Committee shall obtain local weather forecasts and set targets each morning or upon event changes; a radar gun will be utilized. Targets *WILL BE* set in accordance with A.T.A. rules.

In the interest of TIME CONSTRAINTS and FAIRNESS to ALL COMPETITORS, targets shall be reset ONLY if they have become ILLEGAL or if they VARY APPRECIABLY from legal targets. The final decision as to whether or not a trap should be reset shall be made by an I.S.T.A. Official.

ATTENTION ALL 2011 ZONE CHAMPIONS AND ZONE TEAM MEMBERS

Scores used to decide Zone Champion of Champions will be the total of the 50 pair doubles shot on Friday, the 200 singles shot on Saturday, and the 100 handicap score shot on Sunday. Zone Team Champion will be the total score of the 200 singles shot on Saturday and the 100 handicap shot on Sunday. High Overall Zone Team Champion will be the total score of the 50 pair doubles shot on Friday, the 200 singles shot on Saturday and the 100 handicap shot on Sunday.

The Champion of Champions will be awarded \$50 and each member of the winning zone team will receive \$30.

Ties will be decided by reverse score system (25 bird event).

\$100 expense money will be paid to each of the following winners or runners-up in the absence of the winner of the 16 yd. Championship held on Saturday, providing the winner attends and shoots the "Champion of Champions" event at the Grand. Champion - Lady - Veteran - Sr. Veteran - Junior - Sub-Junior. Notify Secretary for payment.

*** * PAY-OFF POLICY * ***

No pay-off reports will be mailed for Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. Cashier sheets will be posted and pay-off checks will be given out at one of the cashier windows during office hours. All shooters that enter options or purses or have Added Money coming for Saturday and Sunday will receive a pay-off report for Saturday and Sunday even though you may not have any winnings coming.

Each shooter who is entitled to receive money won during any event agrees that if such money is not received by him/her during the period of this tournament, a check in payment for the money won may be mailed to him/her at the address indicated by A.T.A. records, and when so mailed, the I.S.T.A. will not be liable in any manner whatsoever for any check lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered or otherwise not received by the shooter.

I.R.S. regulations require Social Security numbers before accumulated event winnings checks of over \$600 can be distributed. Each shooter who is entitled to receive money won during any event agrees that if such money is not received by him/her during the period of this tournament, a check in payment for the money won may be mailed to him/her at the address indicated by A.T.A. records, upon which a social security number must still be provided.

*** * SHOOT-OFFS * ***

Held under the direction of the President and Directors.

All ties must be decided daily, shoot-off or flip, shooter's choice.

Any shooter who does not appear for a shoot-off when called, forfeits all rights. Contestants will be called, 1st call, 2nd call, final call. No response-shooter forfeits.

The Executive Committee reserves the right to decide ties by other means, under lights if necessary.

All ties for singles or doubles may be decided by carryover, shoot-off or flip per management decision and ATA rules.

Tuesday and Wednesday singles will be carried over. Thursday singles will be shot off at a 100 target maximum.

All HOA and HAA ties and shoot-offs will be figured by the computer. You DO NOT need to turn in your scores but MUST be available for shoot-offs as needed.

There is a \$2.00 per event non-refundable charge, payable in advance. The service charge is not applicable towards entry fees. No request forms will be accepted after July 16, 2011.

1. When you squad for a position in any event, that position is now electronically assigned to your ATA number. When you present your plastic ATA card at the cashier counter, the cashier will enter you into that assigned position for the events you wish to pay for. If you do not wish to enter an event that you have previously squadded for, you may release that position at any squadding or cashier window.
2. In an effort to avoid unused positions, it is imperative that you either cashier or release all positions you have pre-squadded for prior to the event. **Anyone who does not cashier or release positions that have been pre-squadded in their names will risk having any or all subsequent pre-squadded positions in their name released by management.** You may call the office at 319-987-2141 if you can not make it to the club in time and have your position(s) released.
3. **A shooter may only draw one position per event.** Any shooters wishing to squad together must fill out only one application indicating the shooters full name, ATA number, and handicap yardage on the line indicating which position that shooter wishes to shoot. Applications for full or partial squads that do not have each shooter's information completely and properly filled out will not be honored. **Multiple applications for any individual will be discarded and will not be refunded. The first application encountered will be processed only.**
4. **Squadding will be restricted to a maximum of 2 yards on a squad.**
