General Shoot Information

The Virginia Trapshooting Association (VTA) shoots will be held at the VTA Homegrounds, Winchester Gun Club, Stephenson, VA. The VTA will have full responsibility for conducting these shoots. The VTA and the Winchester Gun Club are not responsible for accidents or injuries on the Winchester Gun Club grounds.

All current ATA and VTA rules and regulations will be enforced. The VTA reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry. The VTA also reserves the right to change the program for any reason. No entry fee options will be refunded unless an event is cancelled.

On the first day of the shoot, you can only sign up in the morning for that day; sign up for the remaining shoot program can be done that afternoon.

Targets will be shot 50/50 on 6 banks, 2 traps per bank. All handicap and 16yard targets will be shot 5 per station. However, management reserves the right to alter this scheme depending on the number of entries. The squad leader has the responsibility to keep the squad moving through the 50 targets in a timely fashion.

Squads may be reassigned different fields at the discretion of management. If you are on a late squad, do not sign up for an early squad for the next event.

The two practice traps will be the last two traps at the right end of the firing line. There is sufficient parking at that location with an access road. Cost is \$5 for 25 targets.

Shootoffs will be carried over to the next day when permitted.

All options are percentage.

If not won, 50s money will carry over to the next event. High score in the last 50s event will win.

Darkness and inclement weather

In the event of inclement weather or darkness before an event is concluded, shooting will resume at 8:00 am the following day to complete the event.

Trophies

If you win a trophy at one of the VTA shoots, pick it up or arrange to have someone pick it up for you by the end of the shoot. The VTA has no secure storage and will not be responsible for trophies left at the conclusion of the shoot. It is your responsibility to collect your winnings.

Presquadding

We are expecting a larger than normal crowd this year. Therefore, shooters are encouraged to presquad. Presquadding will be available on ScoresR.com.

Money Returned by the ATA

The amount returned to the VTA: \$3249.

Vendors

There is no rent for vendors but please contact Mike Wilder at (304) 919-1025.

Campers

The Winchester Gun Club (WGC) maintains a camping area for trailers, motor homes and tents. Water and electricity are available. Showers and restroom facilities are at the main clubhouse. Rental is \$25.00 per day for 30 amp service and \$30 per day for 50 amp service. You may request a reservation for the state shoot, however, unless paid 15 days prior to the shoot date, we will not be able to guarantee the reservation. Contact Michael Wilder by message at 304-919-1025.

Gun Club Representative Meeting

The VTA Gun Club Representative Meeting will be Friday, July 4, 2025 at 8am. This is a closed meeting, open only to the designated Gun Club Representatives.

State Association Meeting

The VTA meeting will be held on Saturday, July 5, 2025 after the conclusion of Event 9 (before shoot-offs). It is open to all current VTA members.

Classification and Handicaping

The Classification Committee will classify and handicap all shooters. Current averages will be used, plus known ability. Any shooter may shoot targets only to avoid being penalized in any event. All shooters must present their average card and ATA plastic membership card to the Classification Committee to be classified. It is the shooter's responsibility to have his/her average card up to date.

If you have or tie the high score in your class, regardless of any catagory standing, you will be moved up one class.

Special Category Shooters

It is the responsibility of the shooter to declare him/her self as a category shooter for the tournament, if you choose to do so. Once a declaration has been made, the declaration is final and can not be changed. You must also inform the cashier when you pay for each event.

-Parent-Child (under 18)

-Sub-Junior – A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday -Junior – One who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday -Junior Gold - Over 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday -Sub-Veteran - Over 55 but has not reached his/her 65th birthday -Veteran – One who is 65 but has not reached his/her 70th birthday -Senior Veteran – One who is 70 years or older

-Lady1 - a lady who has not reached her 55th birthday

-Lady2 - A lady who has reached her 55th birthday

When we say junior in non-championship events, we mean sub-junior and junior; those who would be junior gold will shoot with other undeclared shooters.

We will follow ATA rule IV, J - a shooter may declare only one category – and rule X, D, 4 - a shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her category will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. However, any special category shooter, whose scores do not qualify for a trophy in his/her special category, may compete for place, class, or yardage trophies.

Target Requirements for all VTA Shoots

16-yard Targets: A shooter must have registered at least 500 16-yard targets in the current year and at least 1,000 targets in the current and previous year combined or be placed in "B" class or higher.

Handicap Targets: A shooter must have registered at least 500 handicap targets in the current year and at least 1,000 targets in the current and previous year combined or be penalized 2 yards in addition to his/her normal yardage, - 21 yard minimum, 25 yard maximum. **Senior Veterans** will not be penalized.

Doubles Targets: A shooter must have registered at least 750 doubles targets in the current and previous year combined or be placed in "B" class or higher.

For the Old Dominion shoot only, the current year and previous year will be the 2025 and 2026 target years.

2025 Virginia Hall of Fame Inductee

Keith D. Corey

Keith D. Corey has been named the 2025 inductee into the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame, recognizing his outstanding achievements and dedication to the sport. Since beginning his registered trapshooting career at age ten in 2000, Keith has consistently demonstrated exceptional skill, earning numerous titles at major competitions, including the Grand American, Southern Zone, and Virginia State Shoot. He calls Christiansburg IWGC his home club and his induction honors his contributions and lasting impact on Virginia trapshooting.

Keith's championship record includes notable wins such as the 2007 Grand American World Doubles Junior Champion and the 2019 & 2020 VA Doubles Champion. He has claimed multiple Virginia State Shoot titles, including the 2001 Handicap Sub-Junior Champion, the 2006 Doubles Junior Champion, and the 2015 Old Dominion Clay Target Open Champion. His consistency and high-scoring performances have made him a standout competitor for over two decades. Along with the notable victories, Keith has accomplished a 200 straight (100 pair) in doubles, the 1st 100 straight in doubles at Christiansburg IWGC, and a 290x300 across all three disciplines.

Beyond competition, Keith has balanced his passion for trapshooting with family, work, and business responsibilities. Despite taking a four-year break to complete his college degree, he returned to the sport with the same high level of performance. With a 16-yard average in the 90th percentile since 2002 and an impressive doubles average of 95.4 in 2008, Keith's skill and dedication make him a deserving Hall of Fame inductee and an inspiration to future generations of shooters.

While it is early in 2025, it has already been a year of significant change for the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame (VTHOF) (www.vatraphof.com). Several longtime officers and board members stepped aside to provide opportunities for our next generation of leadership. I'd like to thank the outgoing members for their many years of service. Lu Charette and Bruce Clevenger were past directors while Alan Corey, Audrey Sharp and Andrea Smith were officers for many years. Alan is now Vice President and Audrey will remain as a director, while we welcome Ryan Bucher and Pamela Meara (Secretary) to the organization.

Incorporated in January 2000, the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization that encourages youth to participate in trapshooting. Each year, the VTHOF performs four primary activities:

1. Provide all youth shooters with significantly reduced target fees at the Hall of Fame Shoot. This shoot is the AIM and Virginia Youth Trapshooting League state championships.

2. Award one \$500 scholarship to a Virginia youth shooter. Information about the scholarship is available on the VTHOF website or from any of the officers and directors. This year's deadline is June 15, 2025.

3. Supply awards and trophies to the Virginia Youth Trapshooting League.

4. Oversee the induction of a Virginia trap shooter into the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame. Nominees have superior marksmanship and/or an exceptional record volunteering to benefit trapshooting in Virginia. The deadline for nominations is December 31, 2025.

As the new President, I'm excited to take VTHOF to the next level. My primary goals over the next few years are to (1) establish a scholarship fund, (2) grow our existing Midway Foundation Endowment so we can sustain our operating costs, and (3) create awareness and education about our past inductees. I look forward to partnering with the trapshooting community to accomplish these goals.


