Over the past 34 years 47 people have been inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame, becoming part of the Idaho trapshooting legacy. The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame offers college scholarships to high school seniors who have actively participated in the sport of trapshooting. Application materials are available through any board member. Nominations for the Hall of Fame can be made for future induction consideration. Nominations are due by May 1st for the following year.

The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame raises funds to achieve the mission through fundraising, donations, Lewis Purses at Idaho trapshoots where a portion of the option fee is returned to the Hall of Fame. Funds are used for recognition events and scholarships.


Kathy began her ATA registered shooting career in 1978 and has logged registered targets every year since. Subsequently, her PITA career began in 1997. To date she has shot 91,000 ATA and 14,525 PITA registered targets. She is an annual member to both associations. Her home club is the Culdesac Gun Club but she regularly renews yearly memberships at clubs across Idaho including Lewiston, Caldwell, and Boise. Over the years, Kathy has participated at shoots in many states around the country with husband, Spud and other family members. Currently, Kathy shoots mostly singles on squads with family and friends.

Kathy's true talent lies in her skills as an organizer and a fundraiser. She has coordinated, set up and advertised countless silent and live auctions, raffles, wine tastings, and dinners. She is famously the Queen of Raffle Ticket sales! Kathy may be small, but she is fierce. Just watch her in action for a few minutes at any shoot where she has her raffle tickets in hand and you will see many people just reach into their wallets with a smile to grab the twenties contained within because they hear her battle cry, "Hey, I need your twenty bucks!"

Since 2010 Kathy has used her talents to design, sew, and embroider the Idaho State Trapshooting Quilt that she then raffles off every year. She divides the proceeds and donates an equal share to the Idaho State Trapshooting Association and the ID PITA. To date she has donated more than \$25,000 to the two associations. In addition, Kathy had loaned her considerable fund-raising skills to help individual gun clubs, both state associations, and various youth trapshooting groups across the state. One example of this is in the early 2000's, the old Lewiston Gun Club needed to raise money for an imminent relocation. Kathy was instrumental in orchestrating at least two live auctions to benefit this cause. These auctions were held at the Camas Prairie Shoot under large outdoor tents and brought in a whopping \$13,000 to \$14,000 each! Of course, the ISTA and ID PITA silent auctions would not exist if it weren't for Kathy. Her ability to glean about \$3000 from others' donated items is nothing short of amazing. She also helped develop the Steele/Connerley draw score for the ISTA state shoot, and she and Spud sponsored Traps 1 & 4 of the ID PITA handicap marathon perpetual purses.

Kathy has been elected to many trapshooting boards. She has been on the ID PITA board of directors for five years and held the office of Vice President from 2017 to 2020. She was also a director on the ISTA board from 2012 to 2014 but currently volunteers her time to that organization by heading up the trophy committee for the ISTA state shoot and has been doing so for the past five years. She is currently the Secretary/Treasurer of her home club, Culdesac Gun Club, and has been for many years. She has been an active Idaho representative at the Grand Pacific, has served on the PITA HOF board and is a regular attendee with her husband, Spud.

Kathy's knowledge of Roberts Rules of Order makes her a huge advocate for the trapshooting community to allow the membership to have a voice in how they want their organizations to be run during annual membership meetings. For many years, Kathy has worked tirelessly to unite all Idaho trap shooters by being a voice of reason and understanding when conflict arises. She always supports orderly dialogue to voice differences of opinion and seeks consensus solutions. Kathy's organizational and writing skills have been instrumental in changes made to both ISTA and ID PITA bylaws by sending in proposals to those organization for membership vote.

Kathy's talents spill over to cashiering, too. Since the late 90's, she has done the cashiering for the Culdesac Gun Club annual ATA shoot and worked as a volunteer "helper" to other cashiers at other gun clubs during their registered shoots. In the early days, all shooter information and scores were recorded on triplicate forms, by hand entry. Cashiering responsibilities were very time consuming and continued several days past the end of the shoot. Kathy was one of the first to purchase and become adept at computer assisted cashiering. In 2006 Kathy partnered with her friend Kathi McCulley and K & K Cashiering was born. In the 16 years they have worked together they have managed to have a little fun and still meet their



original goals of providing accuracy for shooters and accountability to the host clubs that hired them. Their cashiering efforts have taken them from the Hawaii State PITA shoot in Hilo to Nez Perce's Father's Day shoot. They have also been regular cashiers at Grangeville shoots. One time, they emergently stepped in to cashier the Camas Prairie Handicap for their friend Steve Eichenberger who was battling cancer at the time. Kathy continues to tirelessly volunteer her time and energy at any shoot she attends and is well known to all the Idaho clubs.

Kathy was born to Luana and Alvin Connerley and has four siblings: Byron (deceased), Dirk, Janene, and Chris. She is married to Spud Storey and they have two children; Connor, Ali (husband Brian Ferry) and two grandchildren, James and Eli. Her family comes before any score or average. Kathy requested to be placed permanently on the 25-yd line for handicap so she could always shoot with her dad. She could have shot much better scores and increased her average but if you know Kathy at all, you understand that the Average Book was not important -- shooting on the same squad as her dad, Alvin, was.

This nomination would be lacking if Kathy's shooting sense of humor wasn't addressed. I have personally witnessed her shoot guns that have bad triggers, jury-rigged, and pieced together guns by her dad or Spud, and guns specifically made for her small stature. She trusts and shoots any shells Spud puts in her pocket. Her goal always is to shoot better than a 2 on a post, break more than half and have fun. These two things alone have brought much laughter over the years. However, I will never forget the first time I met her. She may not remember but I was having a particularly bad shooting day and as I was walking off the shooting line, this little lady walked up to me confidently after I shot a one on a post and handed me a "Lou's 1 Straight pin" and told me the story of how her mother was named Lou and that was her pin. Also, in doing research for this nomination, I found out that she has also been known to hand out "Fooled you got a 2!" pins as well. I am sure these pins have rendered many humiliating shooting wounds healed when given with Kathy's smile and laugh.

Kathy leads by example by being an honorable sportsman, donating her time, her money and considerable efforts to the people who also enjoy the sport that she loves. She defends their rights and enables shooters to have a voice in the governance of the sport that they love. And, most importantly, she raises countless dollars to help keep this sport affordable for all who want to participate. Congratulations on your induction into the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame.



IDAHO PITA ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTION PROCESS



In an effort to promote competition and to put the emphasis on wins rather than just averages, the following items are used to determine the Idaho PITA All-Star Teams:

TARGET REQUIREMENTS:

<u>Open Team</u> – (6 members) Must shoot a minimum of 1,000 Singles targets, 1,000 Handicap targets and 700 Doubles targets.

Mens Team – (5 members) Must shoot a minimum of 1,000 Singles targets, 1,000 Handicap targets and 700 Doubles targets.

Ladies Team – (5 members) Must shoot a minimum of 500 Singles targets, 500 Handicap targets, and 200 Doubles targets.

Veteran, Senior Veteran, Elder Teams - (1 member each) Must shoot a minimum of 500 Singles targets, 500 Handicap targets and 200 Double targets.

Junior & Sub-Junior Team - (5 members) Must shoot a minimum of 500 Singles targets, 500 Handicap targets and 200 Double targets.

(The Selection Committee has the authority to add additional members to the teams if in the opinion of the committee the scores are tied or the scores are close enough to warrant the addition)

All shooters chosen for the Idaho PITA All-Star Team are selected on the basis of their combined total of: <u>Win Points + Target Points + Average Points</u> + <u>Attendance Points</u>

<u>Win Points</u> – Points are given for every win at every PITA shoot. The bigger the shoot the more points given. See the attached Idaho PITA All-Star Scoring Spreadsheet.

<u>Target Points</u> – 10 points are given for the minimum number of targets shot and then points are added on for the targets shot above the required minimum. Example: If a shooter shot 1000 singles, 1000 handicap and 700 doubles targets at PITA shoots, he would get 10 points for the first 2700 targets (1000+1000+700 – his minimum target requirements) plus 1 point for each 300 targets shot over this minimum. Let's say the shooter shot 900 targets more than the minimum requirements. In this case the shooter would get a total of 13 points toward his All-Star team total. PITA targets shot outside of Idaho count toward target points but no shooter may receive more target points than the total on all the Idaho PITA targets shot in Idaho during the target year.

<u>Average Points</u> – Average points are given on a basis of points for making a minimum average in each target discipline and added points for averaging above these figures. Average points are based on minimum averages established from the prior year. Current minimums are 91% for Singles, 83% for Handicap, and 82% for Doubles.

IDAHO PITA ALL-START TEAM SELECTION PROCESS-CONTINUED

Example: say a shooter averaged 94.5% in Singles, 90% on Handicap and 81% on Doubles he would earn 15 points for his All-Star total. (5 points for each minimum reached and 1 point for each 2 targets above the minimum. This shooter got 7 points for his Singles average, 8 points for his Handicap average, and 0 points for his Doubles average since he didn't make the 82%) These figures are calculated at the end of each target year.

<u>Attendance Points</u> – 5 points are given for every shooter attending the PITA Idaho State Shoot and 2 points given for attending the PITA Grand Pacific. 1 point will be given for attending the Fall Classic or any other Major.

SPECIAL NOTE #1: Your age is the age you are prior to the start of the new target year. Example: Idaho PITA target year is 11/1/2022 – 10/31/2023 and if you turn age 65 after 10/31/2022, you are not considered a Vet until the next target year starting 11/1/2023. This rule applies to all the PITA Idaho All-Star Teams based on their age.

SPECIAL NOTE #2: ATA cross registered targets will not count towards PITA All-Star Win Points but they will count towards your total targets and your average.

SPECIAL NOTE #3: Any PITA Win Points earned out-of-state must be turned in a.s.a.p. by the shooter to the All-Star Committee no later than the start of the next target year.



PITA Rule Change Proposal #1

2021-2022 Rulebook Page 25 & 26 Handicap Yardage Reduction

Current Rule:

After a shooter has shot their initial 500 PITA registered handicap targets with an average of less than 89%, they may request a yardage reduction. Thereafter, reductions shall be based on each 1,000 PITA registered handicap targets or on 2,000 targets for a two-yard reduction with an average less than 89%. A shooter may earn an unlimited number of yardage reductions in any target year.

Proposed Rule Change:

After a shooter has shot their initial 500 PITA registered handicap targets with an average of less than 85%, they may request a yardage reduction. Thereafter, reductions shall be based on each 1,000 PITA registered handicap targets or on 2,000 targets for a two-yard reduction with an average less than 85%. A shooter may earn an unlimited number of yardage reductions in any target year

Reason:

This rule is to correct a shooters ability to shoot handicap at their fair yardage, based on a sensible handicap percentage to be eligible for a reduction. To prevent a shooter from working the system we have within the current rule of 89% which is too high of an average to be eligible for a reduction. The reduction rule is necessary but at the current percentage of 89% is way too high and needs to be corrected.

How I came up with the 85%. Out of all of the PITA shooters that have registered over 1000 handicap targets in the 2021 season there are less than 2.5% that have a handicap average above 89% and less than 1.5% that have a handicap average above 90%. Not to mention there is only 10 shooters out of the top 353 that have an average over 91%. In looking at the top 353 shooters that have registered 1000 handicap targets or more the handicap average of these shooters is .8303.

Further research done by Jacob Ohonich in looking at the last 4 years, the mid-average was as follows:

2019 .8407	2021 .8303

Also in looking at Art Fenton's research of the last three years of the mid-average showing a mid-average for all three years at .8430, it was my decision to increase my original rule change proposal of .82% to .85%







SHOOT-OFFS - Ties will be shot off at the end of each day. Be there or forfeit.

TARGET SETTING – Target setting will be under the direction of the hosting gun club with supervision by the Idaho PITA. No targets will be changed without permission from a hosting gun club representative or Idaho PITA Representative to make the change.

REFUNDS - No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after the event has started. Also, no purse or options will be accepted after the first score sheet is posted. All refunds will be mailed with the payoffs.

CONDUCT - The Idaho PITA and the hosting gun club reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who in any way interferes with the safety, harmony, and enjoyment of this shoot.

GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE - Will be the Idaho PITA board members.

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION - All shooters who have shot less than 500 registered handicap targets since they have started shooting will shoot at 24 yards for the State shoot only*. All shooters who have shot less than 500 registered 16 yard targets will shoot singles in A class for the State shoot only. All shooters who have shot less than 200 registered doubles targets will shoot in B class for the State shoot only.

*Juniors, Sub-Juniors and Ladies may shoot at 22 yards.

ATA targets will count toward target requirements.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

- A Sub-junior is a person who has not attained their 15th birthday. For events where no Sub-junior trophy is offered, Sub-juniors shall be eligible to compete for the Junior trophy.
- A Junior is a person who has attained their 15th birthday but has not attained their 18th birthday.
- A Veteran is a person who has attained their 65th birthday but has not attained their 70th birthday.
- A Senior Veteran is a person who has attained their 70th birthday but has not attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Senior Veteran trophy is offered, Senior Veterans shall be eligible to compete for the Veteran trophy.
- An Elder is a person who has attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Elder trophy is offered, Elders shall be eligible to compete for the oldest category trophy available.
- A Rookie is any shooter who has shot less than one calendar year from the time they shot their first registered targets.

<u>Failure to Fire rule.</u> - You are allowed two failures to fire per sub-event in the 16 yard, handicap, and doubles events. It is not counted as a failure to fire if a "no target" is thrown. Check your rule book for details.

Handicap Rule. All shooters will shoot their longest handicap yardage, ATA or PITA.

BROKEN TARGET RULE - When a broken target is thrown, regardless of whether the shooter shoots at the target or not, it is declared "NO TARGET".

The State Board of Directors and the hosting gun club reserve the right to change or modify any part of the program, if necessary.
