Shooter Classification

Caleb Fischer, Kansas ATA Delegate

>Shooters with fewer than 500 targets on current year's score card will be classified on the previous year's average if more targets were shot the previous year. If the total of the two years is less than 500 targets, the rule for shooters with no score card will apply unless the scores indicate that a higher class should be used.

>Shooters with 500 to 1000 targets on the current year's card will be classified by their current year's average or last years average, whichever is the highest.

>Shooters with more than 1000 targets on their current years card will be classified by the last 1000 targets if they show a definite trend either up or down from the total for the year. Any unusually low scores will be disregarded in computing averages.

>In cases not covered by the KTA rules, ATA rules regarding handicapping and other regulations will be strictly enforced. Any shooter will be disqualified if scores on their cards are found to be incorrect.

Shooters will be classified on average and known ability as follows:

Singles	Doubles
98% and over AAA	96% and over AAA
96.25% and under 98% AA	92% and under 96% AA
94.75% and under 96.25% A	89% and under 92% A
93% and under 94.75% B	86% and under 89% B
90% and under 93% C	82% and under 86% C
Under 90% D	Under 82% D

Juniors and Sub-Juniors may shoot "targets only" for \$30.00 plus fees and be eligible for trophies, but will be charged full price if they play options in any event. Does not include Junior Gold.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

>ATA rules will govern all points not otherwise provided for herein. Interpretation of this program will be made by the board of directors and their decision will be final.

>This is an invitational tournament and we reserve the right to reject or refund any entry which in our judgment would be detrimental to this shoot. The Management reserves the right and authority to disqualify any contestant who behaves in a disorderly manner, or who handles his/her gun dangerously, and to remove contestant from further participation in any competition in which he/she may have entered.

>The Kansas Trapshooting Assn., Inc. or its staff will not be responsible for any accident or for any loss or property.

>No one, with exception of a referee, who is not an authorized puller or scorer, will be permitted to pull or score for anyone.

FEES: AKTAfee of \$2.00 per 100, anATAfee of \$4.00 per day, and Kansas sales tax of \$3.04 per hundred will be collected.

ATA Rule Sec. 4, 110: All guns must have the action opened and contain no live shell at any time, except while the shooter is on the firing line. The guns action may be closed when it is in a gun rack but it shall not contain a live shell or empty shell. Repeat offender(s) of these Rules will be given a 30 day suspension upon a second violation of these Rules; a third violation of these Rules will result in a 90 day suspension; and further violations will be reviewed by the Executive Committee for further disciplinary action.

SOUTHWESTERN ZONE RULES

ZONE FEE: \$2.00 per day, Friday, Saturday & Sunday

- Friday's Class Doubles and Class Singles trophies will be determined by carryover into their respective Championship events on Saturday and Sunday. Friday's preliminary handicap will be shot off Friday night.
- There will be no penalty yardage or classification based on minimum target requirements. Classification will be in accordance with the Rulebook for six (6) classes in both Singles and Doubles.
- In accordance with the motion passed at the Zone meeting, a shooter shall be allowed to enter an event and play all the options/money/purse at any time prior to the last squad clearing the first trap of that event.
- Earned yardage in the Handicap events will be determined by the number of entries of your club. Each club will therefore punch its own yardage.
- The \$3,000.00 added money from the ATA will be paid equally to the Zone Trophy winners for each of the 105 trophies. This will be paid by Zone check via mail after the shoot.
- There will be a \$25.00 Zone Lewis offered in the handicap Championship. This purse is common to all locations and open to both zone residents and out of Zone residents. Entries will be pooled from all locations and paid out 2 places 60%-40% for 3 classes, ties divide. Ties divide. Payoff will be by Zone check after the shoot.
- There will be a \$25.00 ATA Hall of Fame Contributor Award Lewis. Entries will be pooled from all locations and paid out 50% to ATA Hall of Fame and 50% to shooter and paid out 3 classes 60/40. Payoff will be by Zone check after the shoot.
- There will be no class advances for zone singles and doubles events.

WITHDRAWALS & RE-SQUADDING

No refunds will be made to a shooter for withdrawal or scratching from an event unless the event is cancelled. If a shooter misses their squad, there will be a \$20.00 re-squadding fee. NO EXCEPTIONS.

WATCH FOR YOUR SQUAD

The first event of the day will start at the time listed. Be on the grounds ahead of the time and watch for your squad. Your squad cannot wait more than three minutes for you to take your place. If you are not there with-in the allotted time, your name will be scratched and your squad will proceed without you. You will not be paged.

CHECK YOUR SCORE

Watch your score--It cannot be changed after leaving shooting post. The official referee assigned to each trap is there to see that your proper score is recorded. In the absence of a separate referee the official scorer becomes both referee and scorer. Call any discrepancy to their attention immediately. Refer to ATA Official Trapshooting Rules Book. The referee's decision is final.

TIES AND SHOOT-OFFS

All ties for Southwestern Zone trophies will be carried over by sub-event to next like event of the shoot except for handicap events. All shootoffs will be conducted by directors.

GUNS and AMMUNITION (ATA Rule 13, F)

Any shooter violating any of these Rules shall be disqualified from competition in accordance with these Rules. Any such violator shall be referred to the Executive Committee for possible further disciplinary action. A contestant cannot use:

A gun with a chamber larger than 12 gauge. Guns of smaller gauges are permissible in registered and tournament shooting, but no competitive consideration shall be given in recognition of that fact for handicap and classification purposes. A contestant may not use a gun capable of chambering more than one gauge of

shells at the same time. For example, chambering 12 gauge and 20 gauge shells in the same gun at the same time is prohibited. Any load with a velocity of greater than 1290 FPS (Feet Per Second) with maximum shot charge of 1-1/8 ounces, or 1325 FPS with a maximum shot charge of 1 ounce, or 1350 FPS with a maximum shot charge of 7/8 ounces, as measured in any individual shotshell. These velocities are maximum and no individual shotshell shall exceed these limits for the designated shot charge. In addition, no load containing more than 1-1/8 ounces (31.89 grams) or any shot larger than Number 7-1/2 can be used. Shot charges are maximum and no charge may exceed the charge amount by more than 3%.

Any shell loaded with black powder.

CHALLENGE AND PROTEST (ATA Sec. 13, F)

A contestant may challenge the load of any other contestant. On receipt of a challenge the Management shall obtain a cartridge from the challenged party, and if after examination, the management finds contestant violated the ATA rule, he or she may be disqualified.

CAMPERS AND VENDORS

Electrical and water hookups in the area east of the clubhouse are available for campers. Please be sure your electric cords are heavy enough to carry sufficient current. Camping spaces will be reserved, contact Sandra McAllister at 620-546-3519. Camping spaces are \$40.00 Per Day or \$425.00 per year. Please pay at the cashier window or pay on our web site www.shootkta.com. Camping contract is available on our web site and must be filled out and returned. Please contact Sandra before making payment.

Vendor rates are as follows: Prepaid Yearly Vendor fee - \$150.00, Daily Vendor Fee - \$50.00 Vendor staying 3 or more days - \$30.00 per day. For Vending reservations contact Sandra McAllister 620-546-3519 – cell. Parking lot sales will not be allowed at anytime. Violators will be removed immediately.

The management MUST disqualify any shooter with alcoholic beverages on the firing line.

Food will be served at the Club House.

The KTAwill give a pin to any shooter breaking 100 straight in a 100 target event (no carry overs) for the first time on these grounds.
